SUBJECT: EXTENSION OF RENTAL FOR W.H.O. YARDWASTE TUB GRINDER

SUMMARY

The Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Division, is requesting approval to extend the rental of a Model P12-56 HD W.H.O. Yardwaste Tub Grinder to process leaves and garden refuse in accordance with the approved 1989-90 budget.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Solid Waste Division operates a compost program which accepts leaves and other yard waste each year for processing into compost. In 1988 the compost program accepted 1,265 tons of garden refuse for composting. This material was processed using a Yardwaste Tub Grinder which was rented for a one month period in December 1988, as approved by City Council in Resolution No. 88-955.

This Fall the Solid Waste Division plans to increase the amount of garden refuse accepted by the compost program to approximately 5,000 tons. A two month rental of a Yardwaste Tub Grinder would allow the Division to process the majority of this new material. This year only mixed loads of leaves, brush and tree trimmings will be processed by the Tub Grinder. Clean loads containing only leaves will be windrowed without processing.

Authorization is being requested to rent the Yardwaste Tub Grinder for 200 hours during the months of December, 1989 and January, 1990 in an amount not to exceed \$34,000.00. As rental of this machinery is a continuing requirement for the compost program, it is also requested that the Division be allowed to extend this agreement for one (1) additional year, in an amount not to exceed the Solid Waste Division's approved fiscal budget for this rental.

Fuel Harvesters Equipment is the only known distributor of this type of equipment in California. The cities of Davis, Palo Alto and San Diego have all purchased tub grinders from this distributor.

FINANCIAL DATA

Funding for this expenditure will come from the Solid Waste Division's budget line item 415-310-3147-4233 for rental of equipment, which has a remaining balance of \$52,335.87. Funds will be budgeted for this rental in the FY 90/91 budget.

POLICY MATTERS

As outlined in Resolution 89-689, dated August 29, 1989, one of the City of Sacramento's recycling and waste reduction goals is to compost or utilize alternative disposal to landfill methods for the maximum amount of yard and garden waste that is feasible. Rental of the Yardwaste Tub Grinder is consistent with this goal.


