SUBJECT: Bruceville Road Extension (PN:TC36) - Resolution Approving Negative Declaration

SUMMARY

The Environmental Coordinator finds that this project will not have a significant adverse affect on the physical environment and, therefore, recommends that the project and a Negative Declaration be approved by the City Council.

BACKGROUND

In accordance with the State EIR Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, dated June 1986, an initial study was performed. As a result of this study, it was determined that the Bruceville Road Extension would not have a significant adverse affect on the physical environment, and a Draft Negative Declaration was prepared.

On March 30, 1988, the Negative Declaration was filed with the County Clerk. On April 1, 1988, Notice of Opportunity for Public Review of the Draft Negative Declaration was published in the Sacramento Union. The appropriate length of time has elapsed for comments regarding the Negative Declaration with no comments having been received.

Currently, Bruceville Road is not a through street. The northern portion deadends approximately 1500 feet north of Duluth Avenue and the southern portion runs south from Duluth Avenue. This project will join the two portions to facilitate through traffic.

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RECOMMENDATION

The Environmental Coordinator recommends that the attached resolution be passed which will:

1. Determine that the proposed project will not have a significant affect on the environment;
2. Approve the Negative Declaration;
3. Approve the project; and
4. Authorize the Environmental Coordinator to file a Notice of Determination with the County Clerk.
