Sacramento Transportation Infrastructure Adaptation Plan

BACKGROUND

- A. The purpose of the Sacramento Transportation Infrastructure Adaptation Plan (SacAdapt) is to advance the adaptation strategies in the Climate Action and Adaptation Plan regarding climate-informed infrastructure planning and transportation resilience.
- B. The SacAdapt Plan was developed in partnership with the Sacramento Regional Transit District, in recognition of the interconnected nature of each agency's transportation assets.
- C. The SacAdapt Plan was developed over nearly two years of community and agency engagement, resulting in policy and technical documents that will guide staff across multiple departments with integrating climate adaptation strategies into projects, operations, and maintenance. SacAdapt will help the city meet its mobility, safety, equity, and climate goals by advancing climate resilience strategies.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

The Sacramento Transportation Infrastructure Adaptation Plan is approved as the City's guide for climate adaptation strategies to improve the resilience of the City's transportation infrastructure. Additional efforts will be taken for environmental clearance and final design for each project identified as part of the Plan.
