SUBJECT: 1991/92 STREET OVERLAY PHASE 2 (PN:RC71) AND 1991/92 STATE ROUTE RESURFACING (FOLSOM BOULEVARD) (JN:3049/PN:XXXX; PN:SG66) - ESTABLISHMENT OF CIP PROJECT AND APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT OF \$300,000; APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND AUTHORIZATION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT

The 1991/92 State Route Resurfacing project is located in Council District No. 6 and encompasses Folsom Boulevard (State Route 16) from Howe Avenue to Jackson Road (see Attachment A). The 1991/92 Street Overlay project is located in Council District Nos. 3 and 4 (see Attachment B for street list).

SUMMARY

The 1991/92 State Route Resurfacing project will provide a new asphaltic concrete overlay on a portion of Folsom Boulevard and is being funded from State highway maintenance funds. It is proposed that a Capital Improvement Program (CIP) project be established and \$300,000 be appropriated to this project.

The 1991/92 Street Overlay - Phase 2 project will provide new asphaltic concrete overlays for the streets indicated in Attachment B.

It is proposed that the two projects be combined for bidding purposes and that the City Council approve the plans and specifications and authorize the City Clerk's office to advertise for bids to be received on June 3, 1992.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution which establishes a new CIP project and appropriates Capital Grant funds in the amount of \$300,000 for the 1991/92 State Route Resurfacing project. It is also recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for the combined project and authorize the City Clerk's office to advertise for bids to be received on June 3, 1992.

BACKGROUND

The State of California has agreed to provide \$300,000 for maintenance work on Folsom Boulevard within the City limits during the 1991/92 fiscal year (see Attachment C). It is proposed that the funds be appropriated and that a capital improvement project be established for the street overlay project.

It is further proposed that this project be combined with 1991/92 Street Overlay - Phase 2 project for bidding and construction purposes in order to minimize contract administrative and overhead costs.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

MBE/WBE EFFORTS



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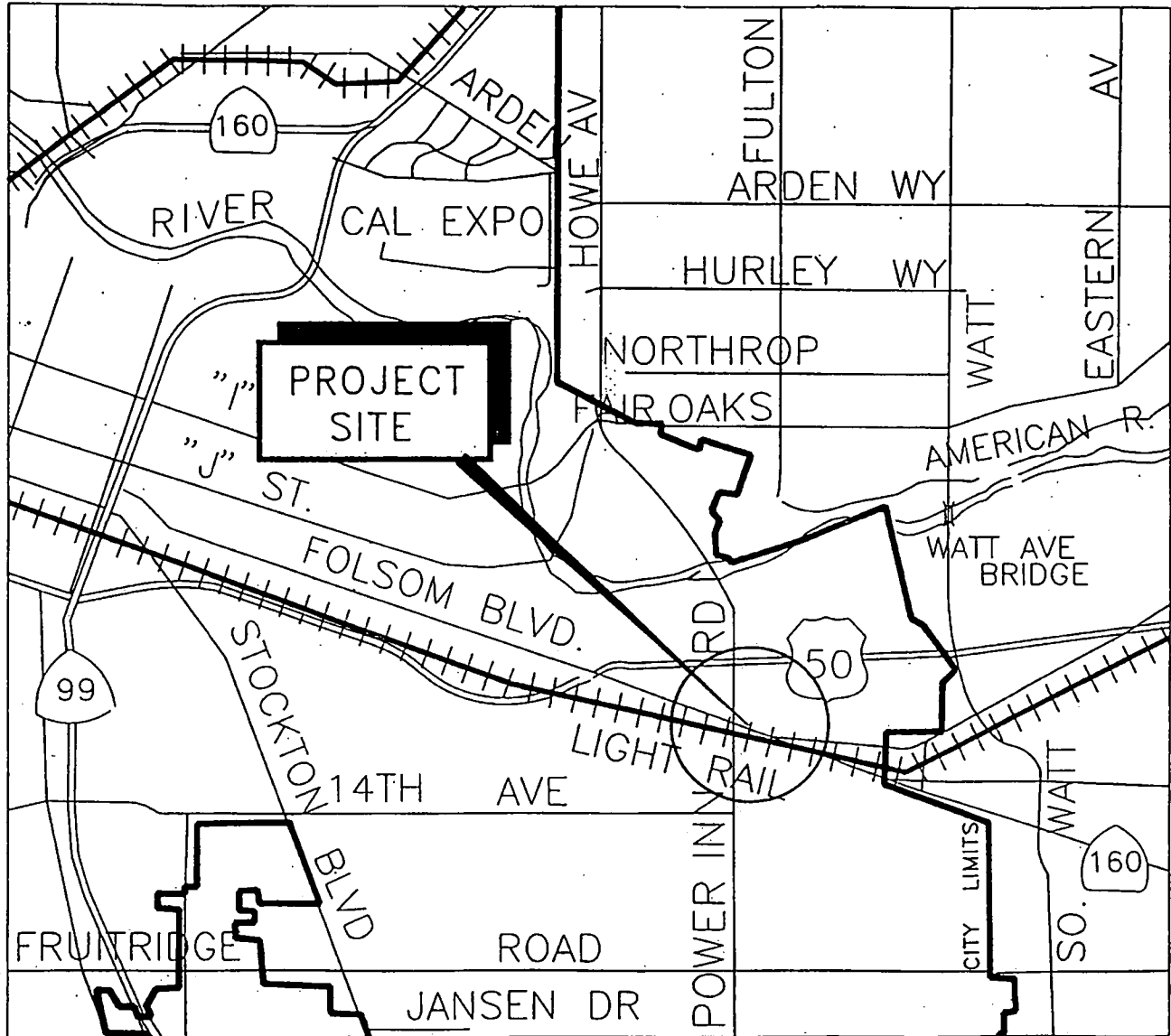
