

SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 51.104 OF ARTICLE I

OF CHAPTER 51 OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE RELATING

TO PEDESTRIAN MALL REGULATIONS

### SUMMARY

This item is presented at this time for approval of publication of title pursuant to City Charter, Section 38.

## BACKGROUND

The amendment to Section 51.104 was drafted at the request of the Police Department to reclassify bicycle riding, bicycle parking, skate boarding and roller skating on the K Street Mall from misdemeanors to infractions.

The reclassification is necessary because the Police Department's enforcement efforts have met with complications. The District Attorney requires an Offense Report for non-traffic misdemeanor violations, and officers are reluctant to go out-of-service for the protracted period of time required for this type of violation. If the violation is reclassified as an infraction, the Offense Report will not be necessary.

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the item be passed for publication of title and continued to February 16, 1982.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 51.104 OF ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 51 OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE RELATING TO PEDESTRIAN MALL REGULATIONS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

### SECTION 1.

Section 51.104 of Chapter 51 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 51.104 <u>Violations of chapter a misdemeanor:</u> ; certain exceptions.

Except as provided hereinafter, Aany person violating any provision of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof is punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars or by imprisonment for a period of not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Every person violating any provision of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a separate offense for each day, or portion thereof, during which such violation continues and shall be punishable thereof as provided in this section.

Any person violating the provisions of Section 51.203 or Section 51.204 of this chapter is guilty of an infraction subject to the provisions of Government Code Section 36900(b).

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 51.104 OF ARTICLE I OF CHAPTER 51 OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE RELATING TO PEDESTRIAN MALL REGULATIONS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

### SECTION 1.

Section 51.104 of Chapter 51 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Violation of chapter a misdemeanor; certain Sec. 51.104 exceptions.

Except as provided hereinafter, any person violating any provision of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof is punishable by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars or by imprisonment for a period of not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Every person violating any provision of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a separate offense for each day, or portion thereof, during which such violation continues and shall be punishable thereof as provided in this section.

Any person violating the provisions of Section 51.203 or Section 51 204 of this chapter is quilty of an infraction
