

ORDINANCE NO. 2227, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING ALL THAT PORTION OF 28TH STREET (FORMERLY KNOWN AS ROOSEVELT COURT) LYING BETWEEN THE SOUTHERLY LINE OF SUTTERVILLE ROAD AND A LINE LYING 20.00 FEET NORTHERLY AND PARALLEL TO THE NORTHERLY LINE OF CAPITOL HEIGHTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. All that portion of 28th Street (formerly known as Roosevelt Court) lying between the Southerly line of Sutterville Road and a line lying 20.00 feet Northerly and parallel to the Northerly line of Capitol Heights, as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County, in the City of Sacramento, is hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.

Said closing and vacating is declared after due proceedings had therefor, according to law and a finding by the City Council, which is hereby made, that the above described street is unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within 10 days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
