**SUBJECT: Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission
County Projects for the Art in Public Places Program,
1985**

SUMMARY

This report recommends an increase in appropriations of \$3,696 to the FY 85-86 budget of the Metropolitan Arts Division for administration of Five County art projects.

BACKGROUND

On April 16, 1985 the Board of Supervisors approved a proposal for the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission to develop art proposals for five County facilities. The Board approved art budgets totalling \$16,680 which includes an administrative budget of \$3,696 to be allocated to the Metropolitan Arts Division to cover costs of art selection. Implementation of the program requires an agreement between the City and County of Sacramento. Major provisions of the agreement include:

1. The Metropolitan Arts Commission agrees to provide the County with recommendations for the most appropriate art work for:

FACILITY

2. The County agrees to pay City for administration of these art projects a sum not to exceed \$3,696.

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FINANCIAL DATA


Administration of these projects shall not exceed \$3,696. Administrative costs, including staff time of \$2,121 and other expenditures of \$1,575 will be reimbursed by the County of Sacramento. No additional City funds are necessary.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council authorize, by resolution:

1. An increase in appropriations to the Art in Public Places Program of the Metropolitan Arts Division of \$1,575 for the purpose of administering the art programs.
