**SUBJECT:** Appropriation of Funds and Approval of Plans and Specifications for D Street Connector, 7th to 8th Streets

### SUMMARY:

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared and copies forwarded to the City Clerk. Appropriation of funds and approval of plans and specifications is recommended.

### BACKGROUND:

At the time when the streets in the Alkali Flat area were abandoned for the railroad right of way, D Street was left without a connection to 7th Street. The Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency has established a project to provide such a connector as a part of the revitalization of the area, to be funded by Community Development Block Grant and the Jobs Bill Programs.

### FINANCIAL:

The City Council has not appropriated funds for the D Street Connector, 7th Street to 8th Street. The Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency has provided the City with an Individual Project Agreement to cover the cost of this project. The estimated construction cost is \$103,000.00, with \$17,000.00 for engineering and \$10,000.00 for contingencies. It is proposed that \$130,000.00 be appropriated from the Housing and Redevelopment Capital Improvement Program Fund for this project.

### RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Appropriate \$130,000.00 from the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency Capital Improvement Program Fund by passage of the attached Resolution, and

- 2. Approve the plans and specifications, and
- 3. Authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on September 18, 1984.
