North Natomas Community Plan, Council District 1.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached Resolutions to establish and/or amend the revenue and expenditure budgets for the North Natomas Landscape Maintenance CFD No. 98-01, North Natomas Neighborhood Landscape Maintenance CFD No. 99-02, North Natomas Transportation Management Association CFD No. 99-01 and North Natomas Development Impact Fee District (Fund 780) for the fiscal year 2000/2001.

SUMMARY:

The three (3) CFD's and Fund 780 provide funding for infrastructure and services for the North Natomas Finance Plan area. To program the special tax proceeds and impact fee revenue, it is necessary to establish a revenue and expenditure budget for the appropriation of funds for each district.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

North Natomas Development Impact Fees

In October 1995, the City Council adopted Resolution Number 95-620 to provide for various development impact fees unique to the North Natomas Financing Plan Area. A significant amount of the infrastructure and land required to serve North Natomas is to be funded through special North Natomas Fee Programs. The Public Facilities Fee (PFF), Transit Fee, Land Acquisition Program Fee (LAP) and Regional Park Land Acquisition Fee were all implemented for North Natomas in Fund 780. However, much of the infrastructure was to be built before collection of the fee revenues. To advance fund the development in North Natomas, a program was established for developers who construct infrastructure or dedicate land to receive reimbursement. We also have the traditional City funded capital improvement projects.

Under the PFF, we request appropriation in the amount of \$1,726,476. Included in this amount is \$800,000 for Habitat Conservation Plan litigation and \$350,000 for the Natomas Habitat Conservation Plan Environmental Impact Study (EIS).

North Natomas Landscape Maintenance CFD No. 98-01

This district was formed in June 1998 for the purpose of funding certain North Natomas landscaping. We project that the City will collect \$180,688. This report requests appropriation of \$180,688 to match anticipated revenues.

North Natomas Neighborhood Landscape Maintenance CFD No. 99-02

This district was formed in June 1999 for the purpose of funding certain North Natomas subdivision landscaping improvements. We project that the City will collect \$77,735. This report requests appropriation of \$77,735 to match anticipated revenues.

North Natomas Transportation Management Association CFD No. 99-01

This district was formed in June 1998 for the purpose of funding the North Natomas Transportation Management Association which will provide alternative mode transportation services for workers and residents of North Natomas. We project that the City will collect \$135,287. This report requests appropriation of \$135,287 to match anticipated revenues.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

All funding for the infrastructure and services are from CFD special tax proceeds and development impact fee revenue. There is no impact to the general fund.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The City's action in adopting the attached resolutions are for the sole purpose of appropriating funds for existing special districts and is therefore not a project for the purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This report is consistent with the North Natomas Financing Plan and Nexus Study, both of which have been approved by City Council. This appropriation authority will allow staff the flexibility to begin funding projects as well as those administrative measures necessary for implementation of the Finance Plan.
