

ORDINANCE NO. 668, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 FO ORDINANCE NO. 602, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED DECEMBER 7, 1933, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TAXI DANCE HALLS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 597, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED SEPTEMBER 28, 1935." AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 602, Fourth Series, passed December 7, 1933, is hereby amended to read as follows:

PERMIT AND LICENSE.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, association of persons, or corporation, to conduct or assist in conducting any taxi dance hall without procuring a permit and a license so to do, after application upon forms approved by the City Council and furnished by the City Clerk. Said application shall be made to the City Council who, in its discretion, may either grant or refuse such permit when it deems same for the best interests of the City and promotion of the public welfare.

No permit shall be granted for any taxi dance hall to conduct dances between persons of different races

Dancing between persons of different races in any taxi dance hall is prohibited; anyone permitting such dancing is guilty of a violation of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be deemed an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; the reason for such emergency is that the establishment of taxi dance halls where dances between persons of different races are to be conducted is now threatened and, unless prevented, said taxi dance halls will be established and will result in interference with the peace and quiet of the citizens of Sacramento City.
