

**RESOLUTION No. 83-360**

**Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of**

**RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING  
JUDGE FRED R. PIERCE**

**IT IS HEREBY NOTED** that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Fred R. Pierce on the fifth day of May, 1983, at the age of 83, in Sacramento, California.

**WHEREAS**, Fred Pierce was a well-known and respected member of a pioneering Sacramento family, who further distinguished the family name by a lifetime of public service; and,

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Pierce served his country in both World Wars, first as a Marine, then as a Navy beachmaster in the United States' invasion of Okinawa, after which he devoted himself to the study and practice of law in his hometown, and,

**WHEREAS**, in 1959, he was appointed to the Sacramento County Superior Court then, from 1962 to 1971, Judge Pierce presided over the State's 3rd District Court of Appeals, dedicating himself to the administration of justice for the public good; and,

**WHEREAS**, this Council believes it proper that its minutes and the official records of the City recognize the passing of Judge Fred R. Pierce, and so, has caused this Resolution to be prepared.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED** that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Judge Fred R. Pierce.

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a suitably engrossed copy of this Resolution be tendered to his family, as an expression of this Council's deepest sympathy.
