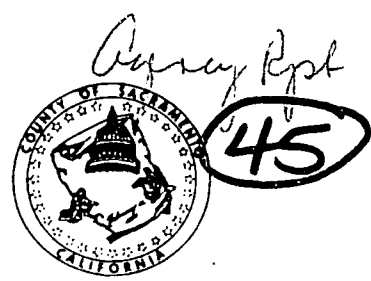

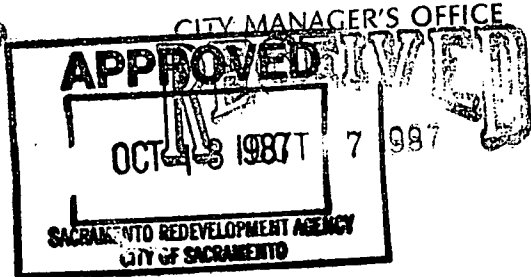

SUBJECT: Realignment of East Del Paso Heights Target Area
Committee Terms to Adjust Expiration Dates

SUMMARY

The attached resolutions adjust expiration dates for the East Del Paso Heights Target Area Committee members so that terms will expire on only one date each year as reflected in Exhibit A.

BACKGROUND

In 1985, the East Del Paso Heights Target Area Committee was expanded from nine (9) to thirteen (13) members to facilitate more balanced representation of the community. In addition, several TAC members have resigned due to illness or personal and family problems.

Because of these events, the Target Area Committee (TAC) now has a number of expiration dates throughout the year. This means that each time a term expires, the CDBG staff and City Clerk's Office must follow a rather lengthy and involved recruitment and appointment process. In order to avoid multiple mailings to the same residents each year and to streamline the appointment process, the City Clerk's Office and the CDBG staff have agreed to request approval of staggering TAC terms so that each year only one appointment process will be required. Upon approval of this report, the City Clerk's Office will notify TAC members of the new expiration dates.

VOTE AND RECOMMENDATION OF COMMISSION


