SUBJECT: Renewal of Sublease to Sacramento Police Officers Association, 5th, 6th & H Streets

#### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On January 8th, 1980, the Council adopted Resolution No. 80-015, which authorized a sublease of 101 parking spaces of the 190 parking spaces the City is leasing from the Southern Pacific Transporation Co., to the Sacramento Police Officers Association. This sublease will terminate on March 31st, 1982, and the lessee is desirous of renewing the lease for one more year at the same rental.

#### FINANCIAL DATA

The City will realize an income of \$1,121.00 per month from this sublease, or \$13,452.00 for the year.

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the attached Resolution be adopted, which authorizes the City Manager and City Clerk to execute the sublease with the Sacramento Police Officers Association.
