SUBJECT: Upgrade Traffic Signs (PN:SC81) - Contract Completion

SUMMARY

The work on the Upgrade Traffic Signs project was completed on July 27, 1989, at a cost of \$190,337.81 and project acceptance is recommended.

BACKGROUND

Chrip Company of Fremont has completed Project No. SC81, Council Contract No. CO88029, dated November 14, 1988. This project provided for the replacement of 1,488 stop signs and 958 one-way traffic signs in the downtown and River Park areas. The increased size and higher intensity background color of the replacement signs used on this project will result in increased vehicular and pedestrian safety in the area.

FINANCIAL DATA

As of August 21, 1989, this project had a balance of \$26,409 from Capital Grants Fund (248), \$5,000 from the Gas Tax Fund (202) and \$1,576 from the General Fund (101) for a total unobligated balance of \$18,140.

Federal Aid Urban (FAU) funds will reimburse the City for 90% of construction and preliminary engineering costs. The FAU contribution for this project of \$212,400 was appropriated by City Council Resolution on November 1, 1988. The estimated City contribution for this project is \$23,600.

Three bids were received for this project. None of the three bids were from minority or women-owned business enterprise contractors.
