**SUBJECT: Construction of the South Parking Lot at the Crocker Art Museum
(CC:2129) - Project Approval and Bid Authorization**

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project involves construction of a 49 space parking lot for use by the Crocker Art Museum patrons. The lot will be located west of the museum, between 2nd Street and Freeway I-5. The lot is being constructed because a planned expansion of the museum into the existing parking lot will reduce the capacity at that location.

FINANCIAL

Additional funds may be needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$76,000. The current budget is \$72,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Parking Funds. The amount currently available for the project is \$58,500. It is proposed that the final budgetary recommendation be made following receipt of bids.
