SUBJECT: Del Paso Boulevard and Lampasas/Evergreen Streets Intersection
Improvements (PN:SB16) - Contract Award

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will install a traffic signal system and a street lighting system at the intersection of Del Paso Boulevard and Lampasas/Evergreen Streets, which currently is devoid of such features. The project will also construct handicap ramps and new round corners at the intersection.

On February 24, 1987 the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on March 31, 1987. The bids received were:

Challenge Electric	\$ 80,163.50
J.D. Electric, Inc.	84,833.00
May-Han Electric, Inc. dba M & M Electric	86,646.00
Richard A. Heaps Electrical Contractor, Inc.	98,470.00
Steiny and Company, Inc.	101,650.00

The low bidder, Challenge Electric, made an error in the extension of the unit price on one of the bid items. The dollar value of their bid is shown with the corrected price, in accordance with the condition stated on the proposal page that the item price shall prevail over the written total price. The contractor stated that he will abide by the corrected price.

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$93,500. The estimated project completion date is August 28, 1987.

FINANCIAL

Additional funds are needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$104,000. The current budget is \$100,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Major Street Construction Funds. The necessary \$4,000 of Major Street Construction Funds will be transferred from the already appropriated funds available in the Miscellaneous Minor Improvements Traffic Signal Maintenance Program.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of Challenge Electric in the amount of \$80,163.50 and award the contract.
