

RESOLUTION NO. 84-484

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING SAMUEL A. PEPPER

IT IS HEREBY NOTED that the people of this City suffered a great loss in the passing of Samuel A. Pepper on the twenty-ninth day of May, at the age of eighty-seven (87), in Sacramento, California.

WHEREAS, Samuel A. Pepper was a well-known and respected member of the Sacramento community whose exemplary efforts and accomplishments were of great value to the citizens and the City of Sacramento; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Pepper retired in 1962, after twenty-five (25) years as principal at C.K. McClatchy High School; and,

WHEREAS, Samuel A. Pepper's outstanding public service career included Naval Service in World War I, and affiliation with American Legion Post 61, Host Lions Club, Comstock Club, SIRS Branch 3, Provident Masonic Lodge and Scottish Rite Bodies; and,

WHEREAS, this Council believes it proper that its minutes and the official records of the City recognize the passing of Samuel A. Pepper, and so, has caused this Resolution to be prepared.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Samuel A. Pepper.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitably engrossed copy of this Resolution be tendered to his bereaved family, as an expression of this Council's deepest sympathy.
