SUBJECT: Pacific Fire Protection District Service Agreement, Addendum #2 to the 1991-93 Fire Department Agreement, and Amendment to PERS Contract

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT

City

SUMMARY

City staff met with representatives of the Pacific Fire Protection District and reached tentative agreement for the City to provide fire protection services to the District's fire service area. Concurrently, City staff met with representatives of Sacramento Area Fire Fighters, Local 522, the authorized bargaining agent for the District's fire suppression employees, and reached tentative agreement on terms and conditions of employment to transition the District employees to City employment. The tentative agreement with Local 522 is identified as Addendum #2 to the 1991-93 Fire Department Agreement.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council take the following actions:

- 1) Adopt a Resolution approving the service agreement between the City and Pacific Fire Protection District and Addendum #2 to the 1991-93 Fire Department Agreement between the City and Sacramento Area Fire Fighters, Local 522.

- 2) Adopt a Resolution approving an increase to the 1991-92 Fire Department Revenue and Operating Budget.
- 3) Adopt a Resolution approving an increase to the 1992-93 Fire Department Revenue and Operating Budget.
- 4) Adopt a Resolution of Intention to amend contract 89110-1 with Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) to provide for the merger of the fire function of Pacific Fire Protection District #1009 into the City of Sacramento effective December 28, 1991.
- 5) Pass for publication, pursuant to Sacramento City Charter Section 32, the attached proposed Ordinance amending the PERS contract and continue the matter to January 21, 1992 for adoption.
- 6) Adopt a Resolution approving the Agreement authorizing the merger of the PERS contracts of the City of Sacramento and the Board of Directors of the Pacific Fire Protection District with the PERS Board of Administration.

BACKGROUND

After several years of preliminary discussions with some fire districts in Sacramento County regarding the City assumption of fire protection services, the City in 1984 entered into long-term service agreements to provide fire protection services to the Fruitridge and Natomas fire districts.

In 1986, as a follow-up to the prior service agreements, representatives of the City and the Pacific Fire Protection District had numerous informal discussions as to the desirability of the City, by contract, assuming fire protection service for Pacific. Those discussions, however, did not result in an agreement.

The City was particularly interested in providing fire protection to Pacific because the boundaries of Pacific are adjacent to the City and close to City fire stations. Three of the City's five busiest fire stations (Oak Park Station #6, Fruitridge Station #10, and Meadowview Station #16) are located contiguous to Pacific boundaries.

Renewed interest in a proposed service contract with Pacific was initiated in July of this year. Negotiations between City representatives and Pacific, and Local 522 continued for several months and recently concluded in tentative agreements with all parties. The Pacific Board of Directors ratified the tentative service agreement on November 26, 1991. Representatives of Local 522 signed Addendum #2 to the City's labor agreement on December 2, 1991.

The significant features of the Service Agreement and Addendum #2 are:

1. Service Agreement with Pacific

- a. The agreement covers a period in excess of 20 years, commencing December 28, 1991, and expiring June 30, 2012.

- b. Twenty-seven Pacific employees at the Captain level and below will become City employees effective December 28, 1991. The present Fire Chief, Deputy Chief, Training Officer, and Administrative Assistant will retire on December 31, 1991 and will, therefore, not transition to the City.
- c. The City will provide fire protection services to the District consistent with the same level of fire protection given to residents of the City. The two fire stations presently within Pacific boundaries will continue to be open unless Pacific payment to the City is reduced by 15% or more from the previous year.
- d. Pacific will pay all revenues received by the District to the City, less necessary expenditures. Pacific will transfer legal title of District assets to the City. This includes all equipment and the real property consisting of two fire stations.

2. Addendum #2 with Local 522

- a. Pacific employees were placed at appropriate steps of the City salary ranges to compensate for the difference in employer pick-up in employee's retirement contribution and the absence of salary increases on October 1, 1991 due to the voluntary agreement of Pacific and Local 522 to forego renegotiating the expired labor agreement pending the outcome of the City-Pacific transition negotiations.
- b. For retirement purposes, Pacific employees will be covered under the third tier 2.5% at 55 plan and will have City benefits of one-year highest compensation and post-retirement survivor allowance applied to Pacific service time. The application of these City benefits to Pacific time was done to partially balance the discrepancy between the two retirement plans administered by the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS).

3. Amendment to PERS Contract

In order to implement Addendum #2 to the 1991-93 Fire Department Agreement, the PERS contract needs to be amended as follows:

- a. The Pacific-PERS contract must be merged with the City-PERS contract in accordance with Government Code Section 20567.1. The merger of the two PERS contracts requires the City Council to adopt the Resolution of Intention, pass for publication the proposed Ordinance, adopt the Resolution approving the agreement authorizing the merger, and adopt the proposed Ordinance at the January 21, 1992 meeting.
- b. PERS estimates the cost of the proposed contract amendment will be .346% of total safety payroll which is the equivalent of \$201,000 for Fiscal Year 1993-94.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

The service agreement provides that the City is to receive all District assets and revenues, less necessary expenses. The 1991-92 District payment to the City for the last six months of this fiscal year will be approximately \$1,105,000. The City estimates its labor cost and expense for this period to be \$1,098,000. Future District revenue and City cost will fluctuate depending on actual experience.

The 1992-93 District payment to the City will be approximately \$1,851,000 while City labor cost and expenses are estimated to be \$1,995,000. The \$144,000 deficit in Fiscal Year 1992-93 will be absorbed in the 1992-93 Fire Department budget. This will be accomplished by adjusting the appropriations for PERS which has extended the funding period for actuarial liabilities. Attachment A provides a projected overview of District Revenue and City Expenses.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

Approval of this report by the City Council will be consistent with prior City Council decisions of providing City fire protection services to special fire districts whenever desirable and feasible.

The Pacific service agreement will be mutually beneficial to Pacific and the City because there will be an improved level of service for both jurisdictions. City residents gain because the two Pacific fire stations will be able to respond and relieve some of the workload of the surrounding City fire stations which are among the busiest stations in the City. Residents of Pacific will receive a higher level of fire protection due to more constant staffing, back-up response, and immediate implementation of technology presently in place with the City Fire Department.



The service agreement between the City of Sacramento and the Pacific Fire Protection District, providing for fire protection services to be furnished to the District by the City, together with Addendum #2 to the 1991-93 Agreement between the City of Sacramento and the Sacramento Area Fire Fighters, Local 522, AFL-CIO, providing for the terms and conditions of City employment of District employees, are approved. The City Manager is authorized to execute said agreements together with any other related required documents.

AGREEMENT

This Agreement is by and between the City of Sacramento, a chartered city of the State of California (hereafter "City") and the Pacific Fire Protection District, an independent governmental entity created under the laws of the State of California (hereafter "District").

The execution of this Agreement is specifically authorized pursuant to Sections 55632 of the Government Code and 13052.5 of the Health and Safety Code.

1. Parties

City is a chartered city of the State of California and its charter permits the City Council to enter into contracts on behalf of City with governmental agencies, including special districts, for various purposes including the providing of fire protection services.

The District is a duly established and existing fire protection district and a legal entity existing pursuant to the Health and Safety and Government Codes of the State of California. The District has authority to enter into contracts with other governmental agencies, including chartered cities, for purposes relating to providing fire protection services.

2. Term of Agreement and Effective Date

This Agreement shall become effective on December 28, 1991, and shall remain in force until June 30, 2012.

3. Intent of Parties

This Agreement is consistent with the desires of both parties to provide more efficient fire protection within District, and will serve the purposes of the public safety, convenience, economy and general welfare.

It is the intention of the parties that City shall provide fire protection service to District's fire service area consistent with the fire protection provided within the City limits, in exchange for compensation for providing such service, as hereinafter described.

District shall retain its existence as an entity for purposes of governing the operation of District, ensuring compliance with the terms of this Agreement, and receipt, accounting and disbursement of tax revenues to which District is entitled, or is eligible to receive.

4. City Obligations:

a. District Employees

(1) Status.

(i) Except as otherwise provided in Exhibit "B", City shall accept as City employees the District employees listed on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof. Those District employees shall be assigned to full-time positions in City classified service, within the classifications set forth on Exhibit "B".

(ii) The District employees listed on Exhibit "C" shall not become employees of the City.

(2) Salary and Benefits. City salary and benefits of the employees listed on Exhibit "A" are specified in Exhibit "B", attached hereto and made a part hereof, except as otherwise specifically set forth in this Agreement.

(3) Workers' Compensation. City is self-insured and self-administered as to workers' compensation liability. District is a member of the self insurance joint powers authority known as Northern California Special Districts Insurance Authority, and shall remain covered thereby through the effective date of this Agreement. At that time, City shall assume liability

for provision of all workers' compensation benefits to the employees listed on Exhibit "A", except as specified below.

Provided, however, that notwithstanding Labor Code Section 5500.5, District shall indemnify and hold City harmless from, and shall reimburse City for the cost of benefits provided to any employee listed on Exhibit "A" if:

(i) The employee had a known and recorded medical condition, injury or illness on the effective date of this Agreement; and,

(ii) The known medical condition, injury or illness caused, in whole or in part, the need for provision of benefits.

District's liability under this subparagraph shall be limited to that portion of the costs attributable to the known condition, injury or illness. District shall obtain from its workers' compensation insurance carrier a letter acknowledging the continued liability of District and of the said carrier under and pursuant to this paragraph.

(4) Retirement. Any amendments to the Pacific-PERS Agreement and the City-PERS Agreement shall be effected in accordance with controlling statutes.

b. Fire Protection Service

The City agrees to provide fire protection service to the District consistent with the fire protection provided within the City limits. The District boundaries for purposes of providing such services are as described in Exhibit "D", attached hereto and made a part hereof. The rendition of said service, the standards of performance, the discipline of employees, and other matters incident to the performance of such services, and the control of personnel shall remain with the City. City shall furnish all equipment, supplies and personnel necessary to perform the necessary fire service. Prior to moving the location of a fire station, City shall conduct a public hearing for the purpose of receiving and addressing citizen concerns, if any, regarding maintenance of fire protection service. City shall continue to make leased space available at Station 57 to ensure the opportunity for continuation of the same level of Emergency Medical Service to residents of the District consistent with the policy of the County of Sacramento.

City agrees not to close a District fire station for the term of this Agreement except a fire station may be closed if District payments to the City are reduced by fifteen percent (15%) or more from the previous year. The fire station may continue to be closed for so long as District payments to the City continue to be reduced by fifteen percent (15%) or more from that previous year.

c. Enforcement Authority

District shall take all necessary legal steps, including amendment of County Codes, required to transfer and delegate to City full legal authority to enforce all applicable Sacramento County Uniform Fire Codes together with the County of Sacramento fire regulations; weed abatement ordinances; Uniform Building Code; and any other state and local laws, rules and regulations which District is authorized by law to enforce.

d. Periodic Reports

City shall provide to District semi-annual written and, if requested, oral reports on fire prevention and suppression activities, and emergency medical services, conducted by the City within District. The oral report, if requested, shall be given by a responsible fire service administrator. An annual report shall be provided in September of each year which details the expenditure of dollars on the direct and indirect support of fire prevention and suppression activities within the District.

e. Storage/Maintenance of District Records

City shall provide archive space and be the custodian of historical District records. On or before December 28, 1991, all such records shall be boxed by the District and delivered to City. The parties agree that, at City's discretion, these records may be transferred to microfilm and/or microfiche.

5. District Obligations:

a. District Employees

(1) All employees listed on Exhibit "A" shall be and remain District employees until the effective date of this Agreement, at which time City's obligation to such employees, as defined in paragraph 4a. above, shall commence. Until that date, District shall provide to said employees salary and benefits, workers compensation, and other entitlements, and shall be bound by all provisions of then-current labor agreement covering said employees.

(2) District shall pay salaries and benefits for those employees on Exhibit "C" through and including their retirement on December 31, 1991.

(3) District shall liquidate, prior to the effective date of this Agreement, all accrued vacation for those employees listed in Exhibit "A" except for the number of carry-over hours permitted by the City/Local 522 Collective Bargaining Agreement on that date.

b. Payments to City

For the 1991-92 City fiscal year District shall pay to City \$1,105,000*. Such payment shall be made fifty percent (50%) by January 15, 1992 and fifty percent (50%) by June 15, 1992.

*Amount will change based on final pro-forma financial statements.

The District shall remain responsible for paying retiree medical premiums, property tax collection costs, district audit costs, legal fees, liability insurance, the Sacramento County Communication system cost and any other District obligations outstanding on the date of this Agreement, except as otherwise noted in the Agreement. Financial obligations of a similar nature in future years will also be the responsibility of the District.

For the 1992-93 City fiscal year and each City fiscal year thereafter during the term of this Agreement, District shall pay to City one hundred percent (100%) of the revenues (including roll over and contingencies) received by the District for that fiscal year less necessary expenditures. The determination of each year's necessary expenditures shall be made by the District Board and an approved budget adopted by each June 30 preceding the fiscal year for which payment is to be made. It is anticipated that necessary expenditures will include, but not be limited to, Director salaries and benefits, property tax collection costs, retiree medical premiums including the established cost-of-living adjustment, audit cost, legal fees, liability insurance, and miscellaneous office supplies. Any increase over 1992-93 expenditures shall require City approval which shall not be unreasonably withheld. Any dispute over a proposed budget expenditure may be submitted to final and binding arbitration. The arbitration shall be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of the American Arbitration Association. The payment shall be made fifty percent (50%) by each January 15, and fifty percent (50%) by each June 15. Additionally, ninety percent (90%) of any District fund balances as of June 30, 1992 and every June 30 thereafter, shall be paid to City. Such payment shall be made by September 30, 1992 and every September 30 thereafter.

For example, if total revenues received by the District for 1992-93 were \$2,000,000 and necessary expenditures were \$133,000 (\$11,000 for Director salaries and benefits, \$71,000 for retiree medical premiums, \$48,000 for financial and accounting services, and \$3,000 for miscellaneous office supplies), then the payment to the City for 1992-93 would be \$1,867,000 (\$2,000,000 - \$133,000).

In no event shall the payment calculated in accordance with this paragraph exceed District's appropriation limitation specified by Article XIII B of the California Constitution. Provided, however, that the City shall be furnished with and have the right to approve appropriation limitation calculations prior to alteration of the formula calculation specified by this paragraph.

The City shall have the right to inspect all financial records of the District.

c. District Assets

In consideration of City's agreement to assume liability for the District's P.E.R.S. obligations as specified in this Agreement, and in consideration of City performing all of its obligations hereunder, on the effective date of this Agreement, District agrees that:

(1) Equipment. District shall transfer to City title to the assets specified in Exhibit "E", attached hereto and made a part hereof. All such assets shall on the effective date of this Agreement be in serviceable condition according to City standards. If any asset is not in serviceable condition, City shall have the right to reject and dispose of it. A list of all such rejected assets, and the reason for rejection, shall be provided to District by February 15, 1992.

Upon termination of this Agreement for any reason, the City shall return to the District equivalent assets accepted by the City and specified in Exhibit "E". Such returned assets shall be in serviceable condition, and as comparable as reasonably possible. Where appropriate, the age and mileage of the assets shall be considered.

(2) Real Property

(i) Fire Station Number 56. District shall convey title to the real property and improvements described as set forth in Exhibit "F" and constituting Fire Station Number 56.

(ii) Fire Station Number 57. District shall convey title to the real property and improvements described as set forth in Exhibit "G" and constituting Fire Station Number 57.

(iii) During the term of this Agreement, City shall maintain the fire stations in good condition, reasonable wear and tear expected.

Upon termination of this Agreement for any reason, the real property conveyed to City shall be forthwith reconveyed to District. Provided, however, that if on the effective date of termination any of such parcels of real property is located within City, then City shall retain title to that parcel and the improvements thereon; except the City shall not retain title to Station 57 if the City is moving party for annexation of Station 57 to the City.

If City during the term of this Agreement determines to purchase or obtain title to or a lease upon a parcel of real property within the District with the intent to provide a substitute or additional fire house for the District, then City and District shall meet and confer in good faith and reach agreement on the disposition of each such property in the event of termination of this Agreement, together with any other related issues.

6. Tort Claims

District shall hold City harmless, and shall indemnify City, its officers, employees and agents, from any and all costs, damages, claims, fees (including attorney fees or other court-related costs or expenses) or other monetary loss arising out of or in any way related to incidents occurring prior to the effective date of this Agreement, or arising out of or in any way connected with District's Board activities or any other District activities during the term of this Agreement.

City shall hold District, its officers, employees and agents harmless, and shall indemnify District from any and all costs, damages, claims, fees (including attorney fees or other court-related costs or expenses) or other monetary loss arising out of or in any way related to incidents occurring after the effective date of this Agreement, or arising out of or in any way connected with City activities or any other City activities during the term of this Agreement.

District shall name City as an additional insured on all of its insurance policies. City shall name District as an additional insured on all of its insurance policies.

7. Labor or Personnel Related Disputes

Any dispute or grievance arising out of or in any way related to the labor agreement between District and Sacramento Area Fire Fighters, Local 522 (AFL-CIO) shall be the sole and exclusive responsibility of District, and the District shall fulfill all of its obligations under that labor agreement. This provision shall be deemed to include only grievances or other claims filed or asserted after the effective date of this Agreement, but which relate to events occurring prior thereto.

Any dispute or grievance arising out of or in any way related to the labor agreement between City and Sacramento Area Fire Fighters, Local 522, shall be the sole and exclusive responsibility of City, and City shall fulfill

all of its obligations under that labor agreement. This provision shall be deemed to include only grievances or other claims filed or asserted after the effective date of this Agreement and which relate to events occurring after that date.

8. Saving Clause

In the event that any part of this Agreement is declared invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Agreement shall be and remain in full force and effect unless the deletion of the invalid or unenforceable portion frustrates the purpose and intent of this Agreement.

9. Future Merger/Consolidation

In the event that District lawfully merges or consolidates into City through annexation or otherwise, or in the event that District ceases to exist as a Fire Protection District and City assumes liability for provision of fire protection services within the area described in Exhibit "D", then on the effective date of any such action or event this Agreement shall have no further force and effect; and,

a. The Pacific-P.E.R.S. Agreement for miscellaneous employees shall be merged with the City-P.E.R.S. Agreement, and the parties shall take such other steps as P.E.R.S. may require at that time. Provided, however, that District

shall not modify its agreement with P.E.R.S. during the term of this Agreement without specific written permission of City first having been obtained.

b. District shall transfer to City any fund balances or reserves in its accounts.

The parties shall make a good faith effort to reach agreement on all other matters necessary or convenient to the completion of the merger or consolidation transaction, and shall reduce their agreement on all issues to a fully executed agreement.

Nothing in this section shall affect City's obligations, or employee rights under Exhibit "B".

10. Reopener

Upon mutual agreement of City and District, the parties shall meet and discuss revisions or additions to the terms of this Agreement, and shall endeavor in good faith to reach agreement on said matters.

Provided, however, in the event of a State Legislative or judicial change in the amount of or method of allocation of special district augmentation fund money, the parties shall meet and discuss revisions or additions to the terms of this Agreement, and shall endeavor in good faith to reach agreement on said matters.

This Addendum is to the Agreement entered into between the City of Sacramento and the Sacramento Area Fire Fighters, Local 522, International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL-CIO on February 19, 1991, covering employees in the Fire Department Unit.

The purpose of this Addendum is to set forth the terms and conditions of employment for the present employees of the Pacific Fire Protection District who will become City employees effective December 28, 1991. Such employees shall be covered by the applicable provisions of the Fire Department Agreement, except as expressly modified and/or clarified herein.

I

Classification and Salary

1. Except as herein provided, the employees listed below shall be granted permanent civil service status in the specified City classification and shall receive the specified applicable monthly salary step placement.

*For compensation purposes, incumbents shall be considered to have met the requirements of an AA degree and Fire Science Certificate with a seniority date of 12/1/70 or earlier.

**For compensation purposes, incumbents shall be considered to have met the requirements of a Fire Science Certificate with a seniority date of 12/1/75 or earlier.

***Incumbent must satisfactorily complete a six-month probationary period with the City as a condition of being granted permanent civil service status. Shift trades shall be limited pursuant to Section 12.1(b)(1) of the Agreement.

2. Any District employee having a known and recorded medical condition on the effective date of this Agreement may be required to have a medical physical examination conducted by a physician designated by the City before the employee becomes a City employee. If an examination is required, the employee shall release all medical records regarding the employee to the City for use in the medical examination, and in any related proceedings. All records relating to such medical examination shall be confidential and available only to the City, the employee, and the Union. The City shall have the right to reject the employee for City employment pursuant to the City's standard pre-employment medical examination procedures as set forth in Civil Service Board Rule 6.12 and Appendix C to the Rules. In that event, the District employee shall be entitled to exercise the review and appeal rights encompassed in Rule 6.12 and Appendix C.
3. The City shall have the right to perform audiometric and pulmonary function baseline testing on all employees listed in Exhibit "A".

4. Employees hired by the District on or after June 30, 1990 shall be required, as a condition of continued employment, to pass on an annual basis a physical performance test.
5. Employees shall be considered incumbents for the purpose of driver license requirements of Section 24.10 of the Fire Department Unit Agreement.
6. Seniority with the District as full-time employees shall count as seniority credit with the Sacramento Fire Department for the purpose of future incentive compensation eligibility.
7. Employees placed at Salary Step "A" shall be eligible for advancement to the next salary step upon successful completion of twenty-six (26) weeks of City service. Employees placed at Salary Step "B" or higher shall be eligible for advancement to the next salary step upon successful completion of fifty-two (52) weeks of City service.
8. Employees must provide proof of the Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Certificate and shall be required to continue to possess a valid EMT Certificate in order to receive incentive compensation for the EMT.

II

Accrued Sick Leave and Vacation Credits

The accrued sick leave and vacation credits for each employee accumulated with the District at the close of business on December 27, 1991, shall be counted as City credits effective December 28, 1991, except maximum accrued vacation credits shall be limited to the number of vacation days usable by the employee during calendar year 1992 in accordance with the City's vacation allowance schedule. The sick leave cashout payable annually for hours accrued in excess of four hundred eighty (480) hours shall be effective January, 1993.

III

Retirement

The employees shall be considered new hires with the City of Sacramento and become members of the retirement plan pursuant to the contract between the City of Sacramento and the Board of Administration, Public Employees' Retirement System (P.E.R.S.) dated January 29, 1977, and as amended June 1, 1978, March 17, 1988, December 30, 1989, and June 26, 1991. The City's PERS benefits of one-year highest compensation and post-retirement survivor allowance shall be applied to Pacific service credits for such transferred employees.

IV

Seniority

1. Employees shall be granted City classification seniority credits based on service with the District. The City seniority dates to be granted to each employee for the applicable classifications are:
