Subject: Recommendation of Bid Award for Sacramento Boat Harbor
in Miller Park Fire Protection System

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as a part of the City's Capital Improvement Program has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends bid award.

BACKGROUND:

On November 17, 1981, the City Council approved plans and specifications for the Sacramento Boat Harbor in Miller Park Fire Protection System and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on December 8, 1981. Bids received are as follows:

Grinnel Fire Protection Systems Co.	\$ 87,690.78
Ahlstrom Const., Inc.	110,494.00
West Valley Const. Co., Inc.	131,650.00

FINANCIAL DATA:

The estimated construction cost is \$90,200.00. Funds in the amount of \$99,090.00 are available in the Community Services Department's 1981/82 budget from the Boat Harbor Fund.

RECOMMENDATION:

The City Engineer recommends that the low bid of Grinnel Fire Protection Systems Co., in the amount of \$87,690.78 be accepted.
