**SUBJECT: 65th Street Bikeway and Street Overlay (PN:HA56/TH21/RC31) -
Project Approval and Bid Advertisement**

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will construct a bikeway on both sides of 65th Street to provide increased safety for bicycle and pedestrian traffic. The bikeway will extend from 14th Avenue to Fruitridge Road. In addition, 65th Street will receive an asphaltic concrete overlay from 14th Avenue to the city limits near 53rd Avenue. The overlay portion of this project is funded by the revenues from the one-half cent Sales Tax.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on July 16, 1990. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$616,300.

FINANCIAL DATA

Additional funds may be needed for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$770,400. The current budget for the bikeway portion of the project is \$55,000 from Sales Tax funds (201) and the 1990/91 Capital Improvement Program contains \$200,000 from Overwidth Pavement funds (209). The 1989/90 Street Overlay Program has an unencumbered balance of \$485,000

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from Sales Tax funds (201) as of July 10, 1990 and the 1990/91 CIP contains \$3,500,000 from Sales Tax funds (201) for the Street Overlay Program. It is proposed that the final budgetary recommendation be made following receipt of bids.

A non-refundable fee of \$10.00 will be charged for each set of specifications to cover the cost of reproduction.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.301 of the City Code governing project approval and advertisement for bids.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications will be sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry in Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE contractors.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on August 21, 1990.


