Sacramento Police Department Agreement with for Natomas Unified School District for School Resource Officer Program

BACKGROUND

- A. In 2022, City Council authorized Agreement 2022-0377 between the Natomas Unified School District (NUSD) and the Sacramento Police Department (SPD) to continue the School Resource Officer (SRO) Program. This agreement will expire July 31, 2025.
- B. SPD has negotiated a new agreement with NUSD for the continuation of the SRO Program. To continue the services identified in the agreement, the SPD will maintain three Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Police Officer positions previously authorized by Resolutions 2013-0067 (2.0 FTE), Motion 2014-0048 (2.0 FTE), and Resolutions 2016-0251 (increased to 3.0 FTE), 2018-0344 (3.0 FTE), 2020-0144 (3.0 FTE), and 2022-0104 (3.0 FTE). The salary, benefits, and vehicle costs associated with the agreement will be reimbursed by the NUSD.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Natomas Unified School District in an amount not to exceed \$2,141,028 through June 30, 2028.

SECTION 2.

The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to maintain the 3.0 Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Police Officer positions most recently maintained by Resolution 2022-0104.


