MINUTES

LAW AND LEGISLATION COMMITTEE MEETING

October 24, 1985

4:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 4:05 p.m. Present were Chairman Doug Pope and Councilman Dave Shore. Bill Smallman arrived later.

Item No. 1: Proposed Addition to Sacramento City Code Regarding Social Security Offset of Pension Benefits. Dave Shore asked Dick Snyder of the City's Retirement System office whether there was any opposition to this matter with the unions. Mr. Snyder said there were none, and that they had been notified of this hearing. Chairman Pope stated that this matter would go to Council with this Committee's recommendation.

Item No. 2: Revision of Chapter 13, Article III, Dealing With Concerts. Deputy City Attorney Dick Antoine was present to discuss this issue. Chairman Doug Pope asked what the problem was that required this revision. There was some discussion as to the difference between Dance Permits, Concert Permits, and Dance Concert Permits. Mr. Antoine said that this revision would more easily clarify whether one or the other permit, or both, are required. The item was passed and will be recommended to the Council.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:10 p.m.
