Carragher was erroneously classified as a stenographer when her
duties are, and have been, that of a senior clerk. It was properly moved by Commissioner Chenu, seconded by Commissioner Deise,
and unanimously carried that Mrs. M. Carragher's classification
be changed to senior clerk and that the proper notations be
recorded on the records.

A request was received from Mrs. Edda J. Fourness to investigate her Civil Service record which apparently was incomplete. After a review of the records, it was properly moved by Commissioner Deise, seconded by Commissioner Chenu, and unanimously carried that the records disclosed that Mrs. Fourness is not, and has never had a Civil Service standing, but has only existed in the employ of the City of Sacramento as a temporary employee.

There being no further business, the Board stood adjourned at ten-thirty o'clock P. M. to meet again at the call of the Chair.
