


ORDINANCE NO. 972, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE AN ENGINE AS A REPLACEMENT FOR PUMPING ENGINE FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to purchase in open market, without first advertising for bids, an engine as a replacement for pumping engine for the Fire Department at a cost of \$2,850.00, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that this replacement can be purchased immediately from The Seagrave Corporation, it having furnished the original engine and thereby having a maintenance priority, and it is necessary that this engine be replaced as soon as possible.
