SUBJECT: Resolutions Authorizing The Transfer of \$6,000.00 and Execution of Agreement between Terra Engineering and the City of Sacramento for the Design of a Sewage Lift Station for the Main Avenue Sanitary Sewer Assessment District

SUMMARY:

The attached agreement provides for the design of a sewage lift station for the project described above (Cost Center 2736).

BACKGROUND:

On October 28, 1981 the City entered into an agreement with Terra Engineering to provide engineering design services for the Main Avenue Sanitary Sewer Assessment District (Main Avenue from WPRR to Norwood Avenue) in the amount of \$19,850.00. Said agreement did not include the design of a sewage lift station if one should be required. Detailed design data has determined the need for a lift station and the proposed agreement provides for the design, therefore; upon award of a construction contract for the subject project, a major portion of the design costs will be recovered.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The subject agreement is for the sum of \$10,575.00. There remains an unencumbered balance of approximately \$9,000.00 from sewer funds in the subject project. Additional sewer funds in the amount of approximately \$983,000.00 are available in Cost Center 8722 (Robla Sewer Master Plan and Construction) for transfer to specific sewer projects in the Robla area.



A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY BUDGET FOR

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN TERRA ENGINEERING AND THE CITY OF
