Subject: GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 84308

Attached is a letter from Brent Bleier, Special Counsel to the Cable Commission, concerning Government Code Section 84308. This Government Code Section may have far greater implications than the single permit to be issued by the Cable Commission. For instance, elected officials serving on the Air Pollution District, Redevelopment Agency, Golden Empire Health Council and Regional Sanitation may be significantly impacted by this law.

Therefore, you may wish to review the matter if you haven't already done so, and advise the elected officials regarding this law.

The Board of Supervisors, at a regular meeting held Thursday, April 14, 1983, approved the policy direction as recommended, deleting the words, "(excluding System design)," so that the direction reads: "In the event there is no acceptance of the franchise by May 13, 1983, the Ordinance be amended to permit a resolicitation of prior bidders for issuance of a franchise which is generally consistent with the terms and conditions of the Resolution adopted Tuesday, April 12, 1983, by the City Council and Board of Supervisors and on April 13, 1983, by the CATV Commission.
