SUMMARY

Attached is a resolution by which you authorize relocation benefits for Clunie Hotel residents who moved out between January 11, 1980 (first notice to vacate) and March 19, 1980 (final notice to vacate).

BACKGROUND

The City posted its first notice to vacate at the Clunie (916) 444-9210 Hotel on January 11, 1980, and later extended that vacate date another 30 days. During this period, before any City relocation benefits were authorized, many residents moved out prior to the final notice to vacate which was posted on March 19, 1980.

> According to the hotel register, there are 62 persons who moved after the January notice. Some of these people were permanent long-time residents and moved out only because of the notice to vacate. For purposes of equal treatment of all residents, relocation assistance should be provided to these residents also.

Therefore, it is recommended that financial assistance be provided those tenants who resided at the Clunie on January 11, 1980, (first posting) and moved out prior to OFFICE OF THE for at least 90 days or more. The assistance would be on CITY CLERK the same terms as benefits for this is the March 19th posting and were in occupancy at the Clunie residents were eligible.

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For your information, 142 residents were registered at the hotel on March 19, 1980, and of these, 121 residents applied for and received relocation assistance.

FINANCIAL DATA

All claims for financial assistance for all eligible residents would be submitted by May 15, 1980. The cost estimate is \$20,000. Funds are available in the original budget of \$118,603. The amount spent to date is \$48,864.02.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that you adopt the attached resolution.

AUTHORIZING RELOCATION ASSISTANCE AND BENEFITS
TO CERTAIN CLUNIE HOTEL RESIDENTS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

- 1. All residents of the Clunie Hotel, 9th and K Streets, who:
 - (a) were residing at the hotel on January 11, 1980; and,
 - (b) had continuously resided at the hotel for the 90 days immediately preceding January 11, 1980; and,
 - (c) moved from the hotel after January 11, 1980, and before March 19, 1980,

shall be eligible for the same relocation benefits and assistance as those hotel residents living at the hotel after March 19, 1980, provided that any eligible resident must file a claim for such assistance and benefits on or before May 15, 1980.
