**SUBJECT:** Resolution Appropriating Funds and Approval of Change Order Number One for Construction of Traffic Signal and Street Lighting Systems at 4th Street and J Street.

**SUMMARY:** This report is submitted to the City Council for approval of Change Order Number One to this contract.

BACKGROUND:

The project called for the replacement of the pedestrian crossing signs with traffic signals and street lighting at the intersection of 4th and J Streets. The current Change Order is for an additional traffic standard and pedestrian head at the southwest corner of the intersection along with the necessary conduit and installation costs. The work was performed on a time and material basis and was necessitated because of a State law requiring signalization on all corners of an intersection if work is to be performed on any of the corners. The Change Order covers the following:

Furnishing and installing traffic signal and necessary conduit - \$5,783.97.


FINANCIAL:

The City Council has approved \$17,000 in the Public Works budget from the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency in the Capital Improvement Fund for this project, of which \$4,800 are available for this Change Order. The original contract was in the amount of \$7,588 and the current Change Order amounts to \$5,783.97, making a total contract price of \$13,371.97. The Individual Project Agreement prepared by the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency was for the amount of \$27,000 for this project, so there is ample funding available from the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Capital Improvement Fund to cover the cost of this change order. It is proposed that the additional \$10,000 be appropriated from the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Capital Improvement Program for this Change Order and any additional costs involved with the project.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council, by passage of the attached resolution, appropriate \$10,000 from the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Capital Improvement Fund for this project and that Change Order Number One for additional work in connection with the installation of traffic signals and street lighting systems at 4th Street and J Street be approved.



RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1984/85 BY APPROPRIATING \$10,000 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AND STREET LIGHTING SYSTEMS AT 4TH AND J STREETS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. Funds are needed to complete the project for the construction of traffic signals and street lighting systems at the 4th and J Street intersection.

2. The City budget for Fiscal Year 1984/85 is hereby amended by appropriating \$10,000 from the unappropriated redevelopment agency Capital Improvement Fund balance to Public Works Capital Improvement Budget (2-06-3110-2400-4820) for the purpose stated in paragraph one above.
