

ORDINANCE NO. 83, FOURTH SERIES.

An Ordinance appropriating four thousand five hundred and sixty-five dollars (\$4565.00) out of the surplus in the General Fund of the City of Sacramento for the purpose of defraying the expenses of erection of traffic signs, painting traffic lines and safety zones, and other expense required by Ordinance No. 80, Fourth Series; and making this Ordinance an emergency measure to take effect immediately.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the surplus in the General Fund of the City of Sacramento, the sum of four thousand five hundred and sixty-five dollars (\$4565.00), which sum is to be used to defray the expenses of erecting traffic signs, painting traffic lines and safety zones, lettering fire plugs, and other expense required by Ordinance No. 80, Fourth Series.


