SUBJECT: DRAINAGE DITCH ACCESS RAMPS ALONG THE SOUTH SACRAMENTO

DRAINAGE CANAL (PN:WD66) - CONTRACT COMPLETION AND

APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000

LOCATION: Various sites along the South Sacramento Drainage Canal (see attached map).

SUMMARY

The work on the Drainage Ditch Access Ramps along the South Sacramento Drainage Canal project was completed on June 12, 1992 at a cost of \$238,713.75 and project acceptance is recommended.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Approve the attached Resolution authorizing the appropriation of \$15,000 to the project from the Ditch Invert Paving and Ramp Program (PN:WC01).
- 2. Accept the project.
- Authorize the filing of the Notice of Completion and Acceptance of Work with The County Recorder; and
- 4. Authorize final payment.

BACKGROUND

Fisher Brothers Inc. of Rio Vista has completed Project No. WD66, Council Contract No. CO91-063, dated October 24, 1991. This project provided for the construction of ramps to the ditch invert at various sites along the South Sacramento Drainage Canal.

The 1991/92 Capital Improvement Program provides for funds for the Ditch Invert Paving and Ramp Construction Program (PN:WC01). This is the fourth year of a multi-year program to improve the accessibility and maintainability of existing drainage ditches throughout the City.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

As of June 24, 1992 this project had a negative balance of (-\$10,303) from the Storm Drainage Fund (425). However, enough funds are encumbered in the project to make final payment and to close the contract.

The current total estimated total project cost, including design, construction and inspection costs is \$390,000. The current project budget is \$375,000 in Storm Drainage Funds (425). It is proposed that the additional necessary funding of \$15,000 be appropriated from the Ditch Invert Paving and Ramp Program (PN:WC01). The Ditch Invert Paving and Ramp Program (PN:WC01) is set up as a parent fund from which funds are drawn to finance various drainage ditch improvements projects. As of June 19, 1992 the Ditch Invert Paving and Ramp Program (PN:WC01) had a balance of \$73,080.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is in conformance with the City of Sacramento's Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction projects, Section 8-4, Final Acceptance and Final Payment of the Work; and City Code Chapter 64, Article II, Section 64.208 which governs budget amendments.


