SUBJECT: Sacramento Boat Harbor Expansion at Miller Park Contract 2 (PN:IA21) -
Approval of Change Order 4

SUMMARY

Bellingham Marine Industries of Bellingham, Washington is the general contractor on the subject project. Approval of Change Order 4 for field changes required by the State Reclamation Board is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project is the second of three phases for the expansion on the Sacramento Boat Harbor at Miller Park. The project consists of the construction of 284 new berths, handicapped accessible gangways with necessary supporting utilities and the replacement of 29 berths, the sewer pumpout facility and modification of the floating building and fuel dispenser at the existing harbor. Change Order 4 provides for the relocation of underground utilities required by the State Reclamation Board as a condition of their permit. The work was not included in the original contract.

FINANCIAL

Change Order 4 in the amount of \$10,890 raises the total contract amount from \$3,294,433 to \$3,305,323. Funds currently budgeted to this project (417-500-IA21-4820) are sufficient to cover this change order.


It is recommended that the City Council approve Change Order 4 in the amount of \$10,890.


