SUMMARY

Approval of Change Order 6 for necessary field changes is recommended.

BACKGROUND

Antovich Construction Inc. of Campbell was awarded this project on October 20, 1987 under Project No. ZB51, Council Contract No. C087022, dated October 27, 1987.

The existing 24 inch water main located in Alhambra Boulevard is in an advanced state of deterioration. This project will install a new 12 inch water main inside the existing line. The 12 inch line is adequate to supply the water needs for the area and the simpler method of construction will minimize traffic delays during the installation. Change Order 6 provides for the repair of a leaking line and valve and the realignment of a water line that was not located as shown on the plans.

FINANCIAL

Change Order 6 in the amount of \$9,380.32 raises the total contract amount from \$434,676.44 to \$444,056.76. This project currently has a \$199,000.00 fund balance (Water Fund: 413-500-ZB51-4820).




