SUBJECT: NEW CLASSIFICATION - SURVEILLANCE EQUIPMENT TECHNICIAN

SUMMARY

This report recommends salary and bargaining unit placement for the new classification of Surveillance Equipment Technician. This class will be used to perform technical office and field work in the installation, removal, and operator maintenance of Police Department surveillance equipment.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

The classification of Surveillance Equipment Technician was developed by staff and established by the Civil Service Board on November 19, 1985.

Currently the Selective Enforcement Section of the Police Department uses sworn officers to install, remove, and perform operator maintenance of surveillance equipment. The adoption of this civilian classification will allow the officers' time to be better utilized in field operations.

Proposed salary for the new classification is \$1,664.00 - \$2,022.63 per month. This salary is based solely on internal comparisons. The salary is in line with the salary range of the equally technical position, Code Enforcement Officer. The classifications have different duties but require comparable qualifications and the same level of responsibility.

Proposed bargaining unit for the new classification is the Office and Technical Unit. Both the proposed salary and the bargaining unit placement have been agreed to by Local 39.

FINANCIAL DATA

There is no financial impact since funds for the new classification have been appropriated in the current budget.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve amendment of Resolution 85-119 to effect the following changes:

1. Placement of the Surveillance Equipment Technician in the Office and Technical Unit of Local 39; and
2. Setting the salary at \$1,664.00 - \$2,022.63 per month.


