

ORDINANCE NO. 566, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE NO. 258, (3S), PASSED MARCH 6, 1917, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT THE OBSTRUCTION OF STREETS, ALLEYS, AND PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AND TO MAINTAIN GOOD ORDER THEREIN; FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE; AND REPEALING CHAPTER VI OF ORDINANCE NO. 17, PASSED JUNE 27, 1872; ORDINANCE NO. 60, PASSED DECEMBER 14, 1874; ORDINANCE NO. 117, PASSED MARCH 26, 1877; ORDINANCE NO. 142, PASSED SEPTEMBER 9, 1878; AND ORDINANCE NO. 145, PASSED JUNE 11, 1879; AND ORDINANCE NO. 138, PASSED JULY 1, 1878."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 258, (3S), passed March 6, 1917, is hereby amended to read as follows:


SECTION 7. No person shall break or injure any electrolier, public lamp or lamp post, and no person, except he be duly authorized so to do, shall at any time extinguish any public light, or any light maintained at any place for public convenience or safety, or shall remove same from its proper location or misplace same.
