SUBJECT: Recommendation to modify the Department of Motor Vehicles Residential Permit Parking Area by adding Sloat Way between 21st Street and the Western Pacific Railroad Company tracks to the program.

SUMMARY

This report recommends the addition of Sloat Way between 21st Street and the Western Pacific Railroad tracks.

BACKGROUND

Residents of Sloat Way from 21st Street west to the Western Pacific Railroad tracks have submitted a petition, representing 93% of the addressed units requesting the addition of Sloat Way between 21st Street and the Western Pacific Railroad tracks to the Department of Motor Vehicles Residential Permit Parking Program. Parking conditions have been surveyed and results show a peak period curb occupancy of 98%.

Based on the petition and survey data, it is recommended that Sloat Way between 21st Street and the Western Pacific Railroad tracks be added to the Department of Motor Vehicles Residential Permit Program.
