**AN INTERIM ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF  
INTERIM ORDINANCE 2002-011 TO EXTEND THE  
EXPIRATION DATE OF THE ORDINANCE TO  
DECEMBER 31, 2003**

**SECTION 1**

This interim ordinance is enacted to address the following facts and circumstances:

- A. Ordinance 2002-011 was enacted as an interim measure on May 7, 2002 in order to establish procedures for review and approval of affordable housing plans and affordable housing agreements for residential projects subject to the requirements of Chapter 17.190 of Title 17 of the City Code that only require approval of adjudicatory, non-legislative entitlements.
- B. Ordinance 2002-011 will expire on December 31, 2002, unless extended.
- C. The City's Planning Department will be unable to bring forward a comprehensive set of amendments to the provisions of Chapter 17.190 in the normal and ordinary course of business until after December 31, 2002, thereby necessitating the extension of the ordinance until December 31, 2003.
- D. The amendments set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance are intended to be consistent with and to promote the purpose and intent of Chapter 17.190.

Section 3 of Ordinance 2002-011 is amended as follows:


**SECTION 3**

This ordinance shall be effective from the date of enactment through December 31, ~~2002~~ 2003 and shall thereafter expire unless extended by action of the Council.


