SUBJECT: Suspend Formal Competitive Bidding of Safety Stairways for Sacramento River Water Treatment Plant

SUMMARY:

The Division of Water and Sewers has a requirement for three (3) sets of stairways to be manufactured for installation at the Sacramento River Water Treatment Plant.

BACKGROUND:

Formal bids were solicited under Bid Number CC 1503 and opened on February 19, 1985. No bids were received. One of the solicited vendors was questioned as to why he did not submit a bid. He stated the project should have been solicited under two bids, one bid for fabrication and one bid for installation. He stated his firm, Pisor Industries Inc., would design and fabricate the three stairways for \$13,340.00, but he is unable to provide the installation service. The Water and Sewer Division will provide all necessary resources for the installation.

FINANCIAL DATA:

Sufficient funds are available for this purchase.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that, pursuant to Section 57.401(c) of the Sacramento City Code, the City Council adopt the attached resolution suspending formal competitive bidding for the purchase of three (3) fabricated stairways and authorize the City Manager to execute the necessary contract with Pisor Industries Inc., 8210 Fair Oaks Boulevard, Carmichael, CA 95603, in the amount of \$13,340.00.
