SUMMARY

Approval of the project plans and specifications and advertising for competitive bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

The steel water mains in the Freeport Manor area have deteriorated to the point that they require replacement. This project will replace the mains in London Street, Sterling Street, 38th Avenue, Dixon Street, Belleauwood Lane, Mc Laren and 35th Avenues.

FINANCIAL

The City Council has approved \$200,000 in the Public Works Budget from the Water Fund for this project, of which \$198,000 is currently available. The engineer's estimated cost is \$189,000.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the plans and specifications be approved and that the City Clerk be authorized to advertise for bids to be received on November 5, 1985.
