- Park El Camino, located at the Northwest corner of the intersection of West El Camino Avenue and Orchard Lane (P-88005);
- Sutter Business Center West, located south of Interstate 80, west of Northgate Boulevard (P-88006);
- 5. Metropolitan Center, located at the Southwest corner of Interstate 5 and Interstate 80 (P-88007);
- 6. Capitol 80, located west of Northgate Boulevard and South of Interstate 80 (P-88009);
- 7. Southeast corner of the I-5 Freeway and West El Camino Avenue (P-86158); and
- 8. Natomas Corporate Center, located on the easterly side of Interstate 5, between Garden Highway and West El Camino Avenue (P-88046 and P-88046A).

Following the OPEN SESSION, the Sacramento City Council may meet in CLOSED SESSION, pursuant to Government Code Section 54957.6, regarding a ballot measure allowing transfer of employees from the City Retirement System (SCERS) to Public Employees Retirement System (PERS).
