**SUBJECT:** Sacramento County Main Jail, 6th and I Streets

### SUMMARY

Granting of an easement to the County of Sacramento to place foundation footing in 6th, 7th and I Streets right of ways. Said easement is 2.5 feet wide and adjacent to their property line. Adoption of a Resolution granting the easement is recommended.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

To build the new County Jail located on the south 1/2 of the block bounded by H, I, 6th and 7th Streets requires that the foundation footings for the building be placed underground 2.5 feet into the City right of way on 6th, 7th and I Streets. The Department of Public Works has reviewed the plan and has no objection to granting the 2.5 foot easement for the footings.




