SUMMARY

Consultant services are required by the Division of Flood Control and Sewers to certify the integrity of newly constructed levees and to investigate stability of existing levees. In response to a request for qualifications issued May 3, 1990, eight geotechnical firms submitted qualification statements demonstrating expertise in the area of levee certification. Wahler Associates was selected by the consultant selection panel as the best qualified proposer. It is requested that the City Manager and City Clerk be authorized to execute a contract with Wahler Associates in an amount not to exceed \$89,899.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Certification of levees is required as a condition of participation in the Federal Flood Insurance Program. The approved drainage capital improvements program funded CIP WC31 to support a multi-year levee certification program. The consultant, under this proposed contract, would provide needed geotechnical services to certify levee stability, to identify needed levee improvements for the South Sacramento Urban Levees and Tributaries Reconnaissance Study, and to identify improvement needs for other levees within the City.

FINANCIAL DATA

Funding for this contract work will be through approved CIP WC31, FEMA Levee Certification Studies CIP (425-500-WC31-4802), which has an unobligated balance of \$207,862, as of August 14, 1990.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

Criteria and procedures used for consultant selection were based upon City policy.


MBE/WBE EFFORTS



