SUBJECT: Folsom Boulevard Drain - West of Hornet Drive
and Camellia Avenue at Carlson Drive

SUMMARY:

The City Engineer's office has prepared plans and specification for the subject project and approval is recommended.

BACKGROUND:

In the Spring and Fall of 1981, the City Engineer's office received notification of complaints by residents and business owners in the subject areas that drainage was inadequate. The complaints were investigated and solutions recommended. The City Engineer's office has prepared plans and specifications for this project which should alleviate most of the problems within these areas.

FINANCIAL:

In 1981/82 the City Council approved \$250,000 in the City Engineering Budget for miscellaneous drainage projects. There remains \$223,000 of unused funds in this allocation. The estimated project cost for this project is \$34,000. Since this project is not budgeted, the City Engineer proposes to use Miscellaneous Drainage Bond money to fund the project. However, no budgetary recommendation will be made until receipt of bids.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee recommend to the full City Council that plans and specifications be approved and advertised for bids and that funds be transferred from the Miscellaneous Drainage Bond fund to cover this project upon the award of a contract.
