AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 11.2 THROUGH 11.4
OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE, AND REPEALING
SECTION 11.5 OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE
RELATING TO FEES AT CITY CEMETERY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

Section 11.2 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11.2 Entering Cemetery Grounds; Loitering

No person shall enter the city cemetery grounds between 4:30 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. of the following day, unless specifically authorized to do so by the Director of Parks and Community Services or his designee.

No person shall loiter in any cemetery or property used or held exclusively for the burial or other permanent deposit of the human dead. For the purposes of this section, loitering shall mean and include entering and remaining in any cemetery under such circumstances that a reasonable person would conclude that the person who has entered and remains does not have a purpose legitimately connected with the cemetery, and is causing public inconvenience or annoyance.

SECTION 2.

Section 11.3 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11.3 Depositing Rubbish and Maintenance of Plots

It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit rubbish, grass clippings, shrub cuttings or other similar materials or substances within the confines of the city cemetery, without the written permission of the Director of Parks and Community Services. This prohibition does not apply to placing cut flowers upon a grave site. (Ord. 3059, §1; Ord. 3864, §1).

Any private gardener or other person providing care to private plots within the confines of the City cemetery shall register with the City cemetery staff a list of plots for which he or she provides the care and shall provide a monthly update of that list.

The City staff shall have authority to clear weeds and debris from any privately owned plot within the City cemetery which in their opinion is not being maintained as to landscaping. The City staff shall clear such weedy plots and maintain them in a "bare ground" condition.

SECTION 3.

Section 11.4 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11.4 Administrative Service Fee.

An administrative service fee shall be charged for each burial in the city cemetery. The amount of the fee shall be established by resolution by the City Council.

SECTION 4.

Section 11.5 Violation an Infraction.

Any person violating any provision of this chapter is guilty of an infraction.


