SUBJECT: Approval of Plans and Specifications for the
Reconstruction of the Keifer Boulevard Bridge

SUMMARY:

Plans and specifications have been prepared for this project. Approval of the plans and specifications is recommended.

BACKGROUND:

The existing wooden bridge deck structure located at 8695 Keifer Boulevard, approximately 600 feet east of Florin-Perkins Road, has deteriorated causing road surface failure which poses a hazard to motorists. The existing wooden bridge will be replaced with concrete culverts and the road surface will be reconstructed, eliminating the hazard to motorists and reducing on-going maintenance costs. The structure lies partially within the County of Sacramento and they have agreed to contribute up to one half of the project cost.


FINANCIAL:

The construction cost is estimated to be \$25,000. The County of Sacramento has agreed to share one half the project cost (in accordance with the attached letter) to a maximum of \$15,000. There is a current balance of \$76,000 in Gas Tax and Major Street Construction Fund from the 1984/85 Miscellaneous Improvement Project Account. Funds will be transferred to this project upon receipt of bids.

RECOMMENDATION:


It is recommended that plans and specifications be approved and the project forwarded to the full City Council for approval and authorization to advertise for bids.



Subject: Kiefer Boulevard Bridge Replacement

We have reviewed the plans and estimate for the subject project as requested. Enclosed is a copy of the plans with our comments.

We acknowledge the County responsibility to share the expense of replacing the structurally deficient bridge, since one half of Kiefer Boulevard at this location is in the unincorporated area of the County. Since the City maintains this portion of Kiefer Boulevard, it is appropriate for the City to be the lead agency for the project to replace the bridge.

On the basis of your project estimate of approximately \$28,000, the County share will be about \$14,000. You are hereby authorized to proceed with the project and bill the County 50% of the actual cost not to exceed \$15,000, unless said amount is modified by subsequent letter of agreement. This letter will constitute a Cooperative Agreement to "cause such work" to be done as is necessary to repair the bridge in accordance with Section 1332 of the Streets and Highway Code.

Please include a signature block on the plans for County approval prior to going out to bid.
