IT IS HEREBY NOTED that the people of the City of Sacramento suffered a great loss in the passing of Norman George Coad on the 21st of February, 1987 at the age of 70 in Sacramento, California.

WHEREAS, Norman George Coad began his civilian career as the first employee hired by the City to work at Executive Airport, and culminated his 40 years there as manager for 19 years; and

WHEREAS, Norman George Coad will be fondly remembered for his longtime commitment to Little League, serving as district administrator for 11 years, being elected to the local Little League Hall of Fame in 1981, inducted into the LaSalle Club Baseball Hall of Fame at Christian Brothers High School in 1987 and serving as Vice President of the Parkway Little League up to the end of his life; and

WHEREAS, Norman George Coad had an outstanding record of service to youth, receiving the city/county Chamber of Commerce Distinguished Citizen Award in 1966 for his work with the city's youth, including 20 years of service to the local Boy Scout organization and numerous awards for adult scouting; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to publicly recognize the contributions of Norman George Coad to our community and in so doing express its condolences to his family.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution Goergebe entered with the minutes of this meeting, in addition to which, this meeting shall be adjourned in respect for the memory of Norman George Coad;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitably engrossed copy of this Resolution be tendered to his family as an expression of this Council's deepest sympathy.
