SUBJECT: FUNDS FOR LANDSCAPING OF WATER AND SEWER ADMINISTRATION BUILDING

SUMMARY

This report requests the transfer of funds in the amount of \$30,000 to complete the landscaping of the Water and Sewer Administration Building at 1391 35th Avenue.

BACKGROUND

The City Council approved a CIP to build administrative offices for the Water Division and the Flood Control and Sewer Division. The contract for the landscaping and parking is prepared and the vendor selected to perform the work. There is \$41,457 in funds available in the CIP (ZB81), and an additional \$30,000 is needed to award the landscaping contract.

FINANCIAL

The estimated amount needed to complete this CIP is \$30,000. Sufficient funds are available in the Sewer Contingency Reserve to offset this cost.
