SUBJECT: 120 Day Exclusion from Sunken Can Collection Prohibition for  
Multi-family Dwelling of over 400 units

### SUMMARY

This report contains a resolution which would authorize the Waste Removal Superintendent to continue to collect waste from underground receptacles in multi-family dwellings of more than 400 units.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On October 28, 1980 the City Council enacted an ordinance that added Section 19.136 to the City Code. This section "No collection from underground receptacles" became effective, after public notice, on December 8, 1980.

Councilperson Lynn Robie has requested that facilities with over 400 dwelling units be excluded from the sunken can collection prohibition for a period of 120 days beyond December 8, 1980. This prohibition is intended to permit large complexes to volunteer for the automatic lift 90-gallon container pilot waste collection program.

### FINANCIAL DATA

This report has no financial impact.

### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the attached resolution authorizing the Waste Removal Superintendent to collect sunken waste receptacles from the aforementioned facilities for 120 days after December 8, 1980.

ORDINANCE NO. 4455 FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 19.136  
CREATING A TEMPORARY EXCEPTION TO THE  
RULE AGAINST COLLECTION OF UNDERGROUND  
RECEPTACLES AND DECLARING SAID ORDINANCE  
TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE EFFECTIVE  
IMMEDIATELY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

Section 19.136 of the Code of the City of Sacramento is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 19.136 No collection from underground receptacles.

(a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this section, the superintendent shall not collect any garbage or rubbish from any receptacle not placed at or above ground level for collection at the times prescribed herein for placing receptacles for collection.

(b) Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to housing projects or subdivisions containing 400 or more dwelling units until April 1, 1981.

SECTION 2.

The reason for the exception created by this ordinance is to permit sufficient time for development of a pilot waste collection program which would provide an alternative method of collection.

SECTION 3.

This ordinance is an emergency measure and shall be effective immediately. The reason for the emergency is that the ordinance prohibiting collection of underground garbage cans is now effective and will apply to large projects or subdivisions unless this temporary exemption ordinance is adopted as an emergency measure.
