MINUTES OF CIVIL SERVICE BOARD

The Civil Service Board met in regular session November 4, 1943 at
5:45 P.M.

MINUTES

The minutes of June 7, 17 and 21, 1943

were approved at this meeting. Miss

Miss Bird appeared before the Board re-
questing information as to why she did

not receive an additional \$10.00 per

month according to the salary agreement adopted by the City Council as set
forth in Resolution No. 200 adopted May 17, 1943 and Ordinance No. 982.

After review and discussion by the Board, she was informed that the position
held by her July 1, 1943 as Senior Clerk was abolished and her present posi-
tion in the Health Department is one of Junior Clerk on a temporary appoint-
ment. The Board informed her that at the present time she is first on the
Senior Clerk Lay-off List.

FRANK DICHIARA

Mr. Diciara appeared before the Board requesting information as to why he was not accepted as a Patrolman after certification on March 13, 1943. After review by the Board of his medical examination, he was informed that by reason of flat feet (2nd degree) he failed to meet the medical requirements of Patrolman.

MANUEL BALSHOR

Mr. Balshor appeared before the Board requesting information as to his termination of temporary appointment as Service Station Attendant. After review of his records by the Board, he was informed that his temporary appointment could be terminated by the department head at any time. He was also informed by the Board that he was certified as Garbageman and was eligible for a position as Garbageman in the Waste Removal Department.

LAUREN R. GROVES

Mr. Groves informed the Board that he was desirous of accepting a position as Engineer with the United States Army and desired information as to a leave of absence. The Board referred him to Rule VIII Section of Rules of the Civil Service Board.

FIRE ALARM OPERATORS

Status

After discussion, it was the conclusion of the Board that Fire Alarm Operators should be considered regular members of the Fire Department and under the jurisdiction of the Fire Chief. It was also agreed and became the order of the Board that the present operators -

After review of our records and discussion by the Board, a motion was made by Mr. Cavanaugh and seconded by Mr. Deise that the request for a leave of absence from August 1, 1943 to May 1, 1944 be denied, thereupon becoming the order of the Board.

NOEL G. ASKEW

Mr. Askew requested the Board to fix the time of the completion of his probationary appointment. It was the agreement of the Board that the time Mr. Askew was employed as a Watchman could not be credited toward completion of his probationary period as "Laborer."

L. O. KIRCHGATER

Letter received from Mr. Kirchgater dated July 23, 1943, requesting a leave of absence after a discharge from the United States Army was read. After review and discussion, the Secretary was instructed to write Mr. L. O. Kirchgater, informing him that he must return to work within 90 days in order to hold his rights, or furnish proof to the Board that his release from the service required that he be employed in an essential industry.
