**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION REVISING SACRAMENTO  
EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING AGENCY JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY**

**SUMMARY**

The attached report from Pat Coleman, SETA Director, recommends approval of amendments to the City-County joint powers authority agreement.

The proposed changes involve inclusion of the new program "Greater Avenues for Independence" (GAIN) and the elimination of liability for the City and County for SETA's actions. Board members are protected by SETA's insurance coverage and by the City and County as elected officials representing their respective jurisdictions. The Sacramento County Board of Supervisors approved the amendments on May 31, 1988 by a 5:0 vote.
