SUBJECT: Sacramento Job Corps Swimming Pool Agreement

SUMMARY

This report recommends the approval of an agreement between the City and the Sacramento Job Corps Center for the operation of the Job Corps swimming pool. The agreement allows the City to operate the facility for recreational purposes to benefit the public residing in the vicinity of the Job Corps Center. The term of the agreement is June 14 through September 3, 1982.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City has contracted to conduct a recreational swimming program at the Sacramento Job Corps Center since the summer of 1979. The joint action taken by the City and the Sacramento Job Corps Center benefited local residents and Job Corps participants.

FINANCIAL DATA

The City incurred a cost of approximately \$4,833 for the three months of operation during the FY 81-82. The cost for operation during a three-month period for FY 82-83 is not expected to exceed \$6,250.
